This course focuses on evidence-based decision methodologies for individuals working in the public and nonprofit sectors. The course begins with an examination of numerous decision scenarios for managers in public and nonprofit settings and decision making models that apply in context of program evaluation, policy effectiveness and change advocacy. Subsequent topics include discussions of various levels of evidence quality, data collection techniques and efforts to understand, interpret and apply common statistical techniques used to support evidence-based decision making. Special emphasis is placed on the effective communication of processes and findings to others.
