Students who have completed masters-level courses have the option to waive out of one course per semester with the approval of the faculty. Students choosing to waive a course must then take an available elective or upper-level course in order to maintain the minimum credit requirement each semester. All students entering the program are projected to complete the program in five years, regardless of previous graduate work
