



Impact on P-12 Student Learning and Development

CAEP Standard 4.1: The provider documents, using multiple measures, that program completers contribute to an expected level of student-learning growth. Multiple measures shall include all available growth measures (including value-added measures, student-growth percentiles, and student learning and development objectives) required by the state for its teachers and available to educator preparation providers, other state-supported P-12 impact measures, and any other measures employed by the provider.

The following school districts and schools often hire Education program completers upon receiving appropriate PA state licensure: Ridley School District, Interboro School District, Philadelphia City School District, Chester Community Charter School, and Widener Partnership Charter School.

The Pennsylvania Department of Education states that districts, schools and teachers are using PVAAS (growth data), in conjunction with achievement data (PSSA), to make sure students are on the path to proficiently and beyond. Utilizing all the data available (growth and achievement), educators are able to make data-informed instructional decisions to ensure the academic growth and achievement of all students.¹

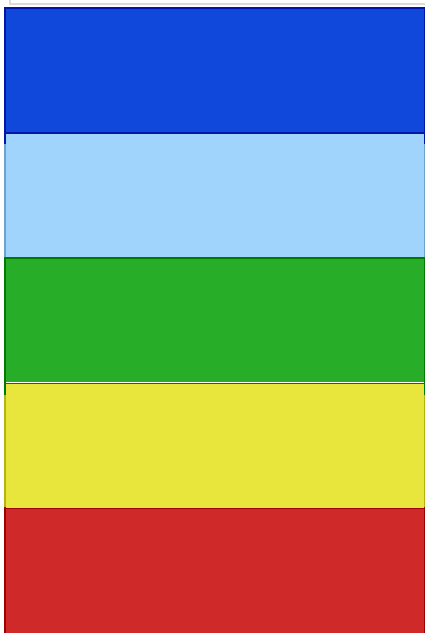
