
Follow these steps to place a hold using Contactless Pickup!

Please Note: Before placing an item request, please check the “Location” field. If the location is listed as Harrisburg or Delaware, you will have to place a request through Interlibrary Loan.

2. Go to the box labeled: “Start Your Search”.


