

Visitor Guidelines

In accordance with current state guidelines and with the Widener University COVID-19 vaccine requirements, visitors are allowed on campus with the following guidelines. The pandemic is monitored continually, and these guidelines are subject to change as needed.

Please note departments hosting visitors do not need pre-approval if the guidelines are followed.

1. Visitors are welcome on campus and must be hosted by a student, faculty, or staff member.
2. Visitors are required to wear a mask while in indoor spaces on campus. Please communicate this requirement pre-event and at the event. Signage should be posted on the door of the event space and exterior doors of the building that masks are required.
3. Events should utilize outdoor spaces as much as possible.
4. Visitors should remain outdoors as much as possible during their visit.
5. Instruct guests on hand sanitizing stations in common areas as well as restrooms for handwashing.
6. Visitors who are feeling ill should not attend campus events or return home if already on campus. This should be communicated both before the event and at the event. At no time should anyone who is ill be on campus.
7. Visitors in residence halls must wear a mask the entire time (including inside student rooms) and must leave the residence hall by 12:00 am as they may not stay overnight.
8. Large non-class indoor events (more than 50 people) should be approved by the divisional vice president taking into consideration the current status of the pandemic.
