The PsyD program does not offer advanced standing to students who have completed prior graduate work at the master's level. All students entering the program without a doctorate are required to complete a minimum of 120 credits on campus, regardless of previous graduate work. Students may enter with a doctorate (PhD) in a non-clinical domain of psychology, and may earn a PsyD in clinical psychology after taking 70 credits and completing internship.
